K4Health POPLINE

POPLINE (www.popline.org) provides electronic access to more than 350,000 records collected over the past 35 years related to the world's population, family planning, and reproductive health literature.

POPLINE is the world's largest database on reproductive health, adding about 10,000 records annually. The database contains evidence-based knowledge for researchers, scholars, teachers, and students, as well as valuable knowledge acquired from the field that enables health policy makers, program managers, and service providers to improve the quality and outcome of their work.

Also included are links to 40,000 free full-text documents, customized searches, and abstracts in English, French, and Spanish. POPLINE provides full-text document delivery to individuals and organizations in low- and middle-income countries.

Many documents—including scientific, technical, and programmatic publications as well as unpublished documents and project reports—are unique to the collection and are unavailable elsewhere.

In addition to free text searching, the database can be searched using keywords from the POPLINE Thesaurus, a vocabulary of more than 2,400 terms.
